The Food bank provides emergency food parcels for people most in need. This is done on a referral basis and referrals can be made through the Covid 19 Emergency Support Helpline Number (0800 783 1966) or one of the local agencies in Carlisle. If you have a regular contact with one of our Referral Agencies, for instance the Citizens' Advice Bureau, Law Centre, Unity, Gateway, your support worker will refer you to us if they think you are eligible. If you have no regular care worker you should contact the Local Welfare Assistance on 01228 221100. The agency will talk to you about your situation and if appropriate issue you with a foodbank voucher.
