Dear Parent / Carer,

COVID-19 Testing

If someone in your household needs to have a COVID-19 test, please can you ensure that the follow guidelines are followed:

- If a household member is symptomatic and awaiting a test then the rest of the household needs to self-isolate pending that test result.
- Household members ABSOLUTELY have to isolate at home if ANYONE in that household has symptoms (until a negative test result is received).
- If a person is told to self-isolate because they are told they are a close contact – they need to isolate for the number of days they have been told to REGARDLESS of any negative test result, however the rest of their household do not need to isolate unless they too have been told they are close contacts.
