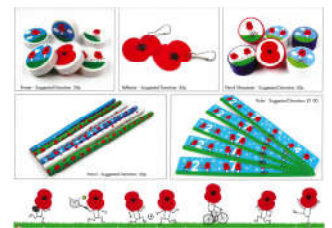
Dear Parents and Community
